CENTRAL VERSE

A fairly detailed list of what each sub-group of people in the church at Crete need to focus on – useful instructions for a young pastor like Titus to work on. The key thrust of the power of transformation through salvation that allows for this change to take place. The end of chapter two in verse 15 is the urging of Paul to Titus to discharge his responsibilities

EMINENT TRUTH

The appropriate teaching and practices of various groups in the church is relevant and important to the overall belief and behavior of the church in doing good and ‘making the teaching about God our Savior attractive’ v.10
